2. One entry per student.
3. Original, freehand artwork in any medium, color or black and white.
4. Artwork must be on a heavy construction paper, matte finish, 11 x 17
5. Incorporate the color purple and/or the "Paint Phoenix Purple" logo or domestic violence purple ribbon. NO computer graphics and copyrighted figures will be accepted.
6. We reserve the right to use the posters for the purpose of dating violence education and promotion. Parents must sign the registration form to give permission to use the art for any educational purpose.
7. Art entries may earn extra credit at the Art Teacher(s) discretion. The contest is FREE to enter.
8. Prizes will be given for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place. All submitted artwork will be displayed at Paint Phoenix Purple events/activities.
9. **Deadline: October 17, 2014, 4:00 pm.** The winners will be notified on October 27, 2014.
