- Incorporate the color orange in recognition of Teen Dating Violence Awareness month
- The logo must adapt well to electronic and print media and to reproduction on small and large graphics
- Original source file must be in pdf format (source file from the winner will be requested at a later date)
- Submissions must be 11 X 17
- All submissions become the property of the City of Phoenix

All teens entering the contest will receive 2 free tickets to the Phoenix Suns Domestic Violence Awareness Game
